

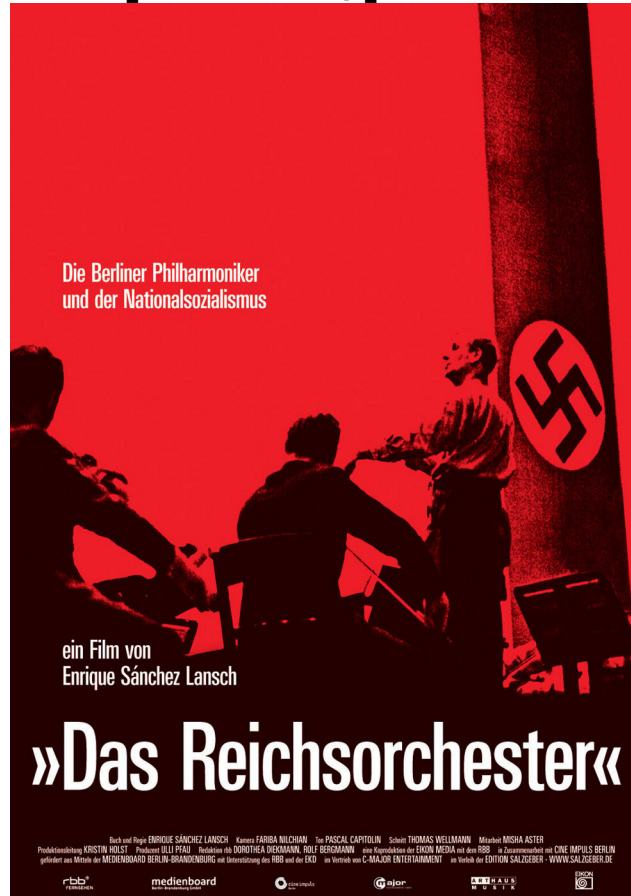

**Interesting doku tells the story of the *Berliner Philharmoniker Orchester* during the years from 1933-1945. Founded in the 1880's, the *Orchester* would suffer several lean years before eventually going bankrupt, only to be saved by the Nationalsozialistische Deutsche Arbeiterpartei (NAZI Party). Direktor Enrique Sanchez Lansch interviews former members and their children about life during these years. Apparently by remaining in Germany during the war, legendary Conductor Wilhelm Furtwängler was able to successfully protect halb-Jude (half Jewish people), husbands of Jewish people and also kept his musicians from being sent off to war.
